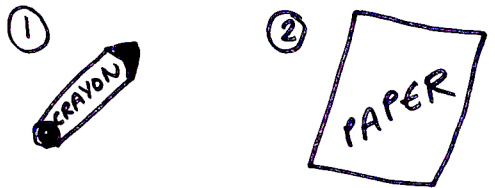


COLLAGE

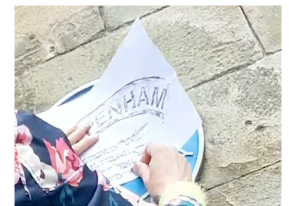


*Follow these steps to
make your own collage!*

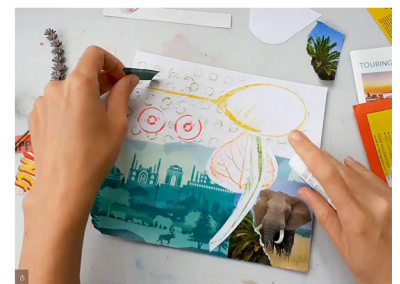
1. Find some interesting objects at home or somewhere historical to investigate.



2. Lay a sheet of paper over your object and rub gently with a crayon onto the paper. You should see an impression of the object coming through. Use the side of the crayon.



3. Cut out a base for your collage from cardboard. Cut or tear out interesting words and pictures from flyers and magazines. You could choose to make the collage about where you live.



4. Arrange your rubbings, words and images onto the cardboard base and use glue to stick them down.

5. You can paint over your collage with PVA glue to protect it (optional)

Your collage is ready!
